OVERVIEW

Spanish is taught in weekly lessons of 45 minutes in length for EYFS, KS1 AND KS2 pupils.

Lesson plans include games, stories, songs, phonics, grammar and sentence-building activities, rhymes, role-play, and dictionary work.

The scheme of work is based on the national curriculum, ensuring coverage of reading, writing, speaking, and listening. It also includes a wide range of activities related to culture, celebrations, art, music, and food to meet the diversity of the Spanish language, which is spoken in 21 countries around the world.

Through Pen Pal activities, pupils will have the opportunity to meet other Spanish learners primarily based in London and learners of English living in Spain or any other Spanish-speaking country. They will also have the opportunity to travel to Spain in year 5.
